

Create Toad Habitat

Toads are wonderful to have in the garden. They can eat 1000 insects a day! So how do you attract (and keep) these helpful critters in your yard? Every animal needs food, water, shelter, oxygen and space.



Food

1. Plant native plants. These will attract insects that the toads eat.

Toad Waterer

1. Toads drink water through a seat pouch on their abdomen. Place a shallow dish in the shade near the clay pot house. Add some rocks for the toads to climb out on. Change the water once a week.

Clay Pot Toad House

- 1. Take a clay pot and turn it upside down. Elevate the front of the pot using rocks, giving toads enough space to get under the rim.
- 2. Place your clay pot house in a shady area.

Oxygen

1. Toads breathe through their skin and their lungs.

Space

1. Toads are not territorial and you don't need to provide anything else for them.
