Proposed Revisions to the New Jersey State Implementation Plan for the Attainment and Maintenance of the Carbon Monoxide and One-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is proposing revisions to the New Jersey State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the Attainment and Maintenance of the Carbon Monoxide and One-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards - New Jersey Revised Motor Vehicle Transportation Conformity Budgets Using the MOBILE6 Model. These proposed revisions are now available for inspection.

A public hearing is scheduled on the proposal on April 14, 2004, at 10:00 a.m. at the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, 401 E. State Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08625. This hearing is being held in accordance with the provisions of Section 110(a)(2) of the Clean Air Act, 42U.S.C. §7410: the Air Pollution Control Act (1954), N.J.S.A. 26:2C-1 et seq. and the Administrative Procedures Act, N.J.S.A. 52:14 B-1 et seq. This SIP revision is necessary to revise transportation conformity budgets for carbon monoxide and the ozone precursors, volatile organic compounds (VOC) and oxides of nitrogen (NO_v).

The carbon monoxide budgets must be updated at this time because the Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) must use the MOBILE6 model in 2004 for their carbon monoxide transportation conformity determinations. Because the MOBILE6 model predicts carbon monoxide levels that are significantly higher than those predicted by MOBILE5 the budgets will need to be revised using MOBILE6 to enable the MPO's to demonstrate conformity. However, even with MOBILE6, carbon monoxide emissions are decreasing significantly over time, and air quality monitoring data continues to show a trend of improving carbon monoxide air quality in New Jersey with current levels well below the National Ambient Air Quality Standard. Therefore, except for this change in budgets, no modifications to the carbon monoxide maintenance plans are warranted.

This SIP contains revision also VOC an update to the and $NO_{^{\vee}}$ transportationconformity budgets for the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority counties. This update is needed because of a recent update to vehicle data used in the modeling process. The update involves a slight increase in the NO, budget and a significant decrease in the VOC budget. This SIP revision shows that the updated budgets continue to support predicted achievement of rate of progress requirements and projected attainment of the one-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard for the Northern New Jersey/New York City/Long Island nonattainment area.

The NJDEP is seeking comment from the public on all aspects of this proposed SIP revision. Written and/or oral testimony concerning the proposed SIP revision will be received at a public hearing held on:
