- 2. Update Monitoring/Recordkeeping/Reporting Requirements
- 3. Update Applicable Rules
- 4. Restructure if Requested
- 5. Incorporate 7-day Notices Changes
- 6. Update Insignificant Sources
- 7. Incorporate any GOPs**
