DISCONTINUATION OF GPS

Discontinuation of GP-020 Research and Development (R & D)

- Public Comments Period for the Discontinuation ended on September 17, 2021.
- The Department received few comments, and we are working to the Response to Comments.
- The Department will prepare the Response to Comments Document:
 - will send copy to those who commented; and
 - will be available in our website for review

REGISTRATION UNDER CONSTRUCTION

- R-001 Registration form for Used Oil Space Heaters
 - The purpose is to create the registration online.
 - It will be a separate section in Portal for "Registrations"
 - R-001 is in the last stage of testing
 - Tentative Date for availability December 2021

GP-005A AND GP-005B EMERGENCY GENERATORS

Issue:

- Applicant needs an air permit to secure federal/state funding.
- Applicant doesn't have the correct Manufacturer, Model and Model Year at the time of permitting.

Solution:

- As long as the engine is a true <u>emergency generator</u> as defined in Subchapter 19, it is okay to obtain a GP-005A for Diesel Engines and/or a GP-005B for Natural Gas Engines.
- Once the funding is available and have the specific engine's information, applicant is expected to re-permit the source(s) with the correct entry.
