











RGGI Total Auction Proceeds & Clearing Price




New Jersey RGGI Timeline





"RGGI Certificate of Representation Form" U.S. EPA, so that EPA/CAMD is authorized for COATS.

RGGI PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

The Department's Air Program (permit applications and revisions)

The Bureau of Climate Change and Clean Energy (program implementation, coordinates with RGGI, Inc., oversees auction proceeds)


