Major Sources - Title V Stack Test Extensions

N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.18(k) provides conditions under which a Title V permittee may seek approval for a delay in testing required pursuant to its Operating Permit. Section (k)3 describes conditions under which the Department shall review each request for delay (up to 90 days each). Stack tests extension requests shall be processed as follows:

- For stack test extensions due to reasons outlined in N.J.A.C. 7-22.18 (k)(3), the
 Permittee may submit an extension request for Department review and approval as
 long as the Permittee's operating permit specifically allows for it in the General
 Provisions. Such requests shall be submitted to the appropriate Regional
 Enforcement Office consistent with N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.18 (k)(1) and (2).
- For stack test extension requests due to reasons other than those outlined in N.J.A.C. 22.18 (k)(3), the Permittee shall submit a significant permit modification to the Department for review. Such requests will be reviewed and decided on a caseby-case basis.
