NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PRECONSTRUCTION PERMIT

The New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is seeking public comment on its intent to approve an Air Pollution Control Preconstruction Permit for Seaside Cemetery Company pursuant to the provisions of Air Pollution Control Act of Chapter 106, P.L. 1967 (N.J.S.A. 26:2C-1 et. seq.) and state regulation promulgated at N.J.A.C. 7:27-8. These rules require that any significant source of air contaminant emissions must obtain a preconstruction permit prior to construction, reconstruction, installation, or modification.

FACILITY INFORMATION

Seaside Cemetery Company located 559 Rt 9 S, Marmora, NJ, 08223, plans to replace one human cremation retort with a maximum processing capacity of 100 pounds per hours with a new human cremation retort with a maximum processing capacity of 150 pounds per hour for a net increase of 50 pounds per hour for the facility. The facility will monitor and record the material throughput, the temperature at the exit of the secondary chamber, and the hours of operation to ensure that the emission limits of the permit are not exceeded.

The statement of issues shall be relevant to the draft permit under review by the Department.
