Proposed General Permit (GP-021A), Indoor Fumigation Operations of Cocoa Bean Products

Take notice that the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is seeking public comment on a proposed general permit GP-021A for indoor fumigation operations of cocoa bean products at minor air facilities.

This new general permit would allow for the construction, installation, reconstruction, modification, and operation of single or multiple industrial structures, limited to tarpaulin enclosure for sulfuryl fluoride fumigation of cocoa beans products.

A general permit is a pre-approved permit to construct and certificate to operate, issued pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:27-8.8, for one or more types of similar sources at a minor facility. A minor facility with a qualifying source may register for and operate under the conditions of the general permit, rather than submit a case-by-case permit application.
