Permit Descriptions

CAFRA - A Coastal Area Facility Act permit is required to construct residential, commercial, public, transportation, utility and energy-related facilities in the coastal area as defined by the Act.

Federal Consistency Activity: Certain federal permits, not limited to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permits, require certification by the DEP prior to the issuance of the permit by the federal agency.

Freshwater Wetlands: A Permit (Letters of Exemption, Letters of Interpretation, Statewide General Permit, Open Water Fill, Individual, Transition Area Waiver, Water Quality Certificate) is needed prior to engaging in a regulated activity in or around freshwater wetlands and associated transition areas. A Flood Hazard Area Permit, an U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permit, and a Water Quality Certification may also be required.

General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup: This general permit authorizes the surface water discharge of treated groundwater previously contaminated with petroleum products.

NJPDES permits: A permit is required for the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwater, a discharge from an indirect user or the land application of municipal and/or industrial residuals. (A more comprehensive definition of activities, which require a permit, may be found at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-2.4)

Solid Waste Facility: A permit is required to conduct or operate any solid waste facility as defined under the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 et seq.

Tidal Wetlands: A Coastal Wetlands Permit is needed to excavate, dredge, fill or erect structures on coastal wetlands.

Treatment Works Approval: A TWA permit is required for the construction, modification or operation of a treatment works, including sanitary/industrial sewage pretreatment or treatment systems, sewage conveyance systems, sewer extensions and subsurface sewage disposal systems.

Waterfront Development: A permit is required for any project involving the development of waterfront near or upon any tidal or navigable waterway in the State.

Coastal Wetlands: A permit authorizing disturbances to Mapped Tidal Wetlands under the Wetlands Act of 1970, N.J.S.A. 13:9A”

General Information

The DEP Bulletin is an information service provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. In compliance with the Rules and Regulations Governing 90 Day Construction Permits (NJAC 7:1C-1.1 et seq.) this semi-monthly publication contains a list of construction permit applications recently filed or acted upon by the DEP. Using the Application Milestone Codes located on the inside front cover, interested persons can determine the status of Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits, Federal Consistency Activity permits, Freshwater Wetlands Individual and Statewide General permits, General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup permits, Open Water Fill permits, Solid Waste Facility permits (SWF), Flood Hazard Area (FHA) permits, Tidal Wetlands permits, Waterfront Development permits and Treatment Works Approvals (TWA).

In addition, a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings is provided. The public hearings listed do not, however, constitute an official notice. Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the period are also shown. Additional information concerning the permit applications can be obtained by calling the project manager at the appropriate office listed on the inside back cover.

Public Hearings are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide or of broad general interest and open to the public.

Contested Case Hearings are held between the State and a particular party involving an application, enforcement violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP Events of Public Interest include public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

FLOOD HAZARD AREA APPLICABILITY DETERMINATION**

TAKE NOTICE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION has agreed to issue a revised flood hazard area applicability determination, which would clarify that the proposed construction of a second-story and third-story addition to an existing private residence located along Swan Creek is located outside the flood hazard area and furthermore eligible for automatic approval under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act rules via a permit-by-rule at N.J.A.C. 7:13-7.2(a)2. Take Notice that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Division of Parks and Forestry (Division), as part of the New Jersey No Net Loss Reforestation Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1L-14.1 et seq.), will conduct two Public Forums to allow Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (“Tennessee”) to present its plans for deforestation and reforestation on State- owned lands associated with the installation of two natural gas pipeline loops proposed by Tennessee, as part of it Northeast Upgrade Project (the “Project”). Tennessee submitted one reforestation plan for each loop and, therefore, NJDEP will conduct two public forums to present and take comment on each plan.

The New Jersey portion of the Project consists of two natural gas pipeline loops, referred to as “Loop 323” (a portion of which is located in Pennsylvania) and “Loop 325”. As proposed to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) in March 2011, the Project is approximately 17.61 miles in length in New Jersey and extends west to east, traversing Sussex, Passaic and Bergen Counties. Approximately ten miles of the New Jersey portion of Loop 323 will be located in Sussex County, with 7.6 miles for Loop 325 located within Passaic and Bergen Counties. As proposed, the Project will be located primarily within Tennessee’s existing pipeline right of way and adjacent to its existing pipeline, to the extent practicable, feasible, and in compliance with existing law. The State lands proposed to be crossed by Loop 323 include lands in High Point State Park in Montague and Wantage Townships, Sussex County. The State lands proposed to be crossed by Loop 325 include lands in Long Pond Ironworks State Park, in West Milford Township and Ringwood Borough, Passaic County, and in Ringwood State Park, Ringwood Borough, Passaic County, and Mahwah Township, Bergen County.

Each Reforestation Plan, as well as informational documents and supporting mapping, will be made available to the public at the respective Public Forum. Each Reforestation Plan will also be posted on the NJDEP website, <http://www.state.nj.us/dep/parksandforests/forest/community/index.html>, and will be available to the public at the Municipal Clerk’s offices in the municipalities in which the impacted State-lands are located beginning on the date of each Public Forum.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program

Notice of Public Hearings on Proposed Conveyance (Lease) of State-owned Lands in High Point State Park (Montague Township, Sussex County), Long Pond Ironworks State Park (West Milford Township and Ringwood Borough, Passaic County) and Ringwood State Park (Ringwood Borough, Passaic County and Mahwah Township, Bergen County)

Take Notice that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 13:1D-51 through 58, the State of New Jersey, Department of Environmental Protection (“NJDEP” or “Department”), Green Acres Program, will hold three **public hearings** to seek comments on a proposed 25-year conveyance (lease) to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (“Tennessee”) of certain State-owned lands, described more specifically below, in High Point State Park (Montague Township, Sussex County), Long Pond Ironworks State Park (West Milford Township and Ringwood Borough, Passaic County), and Ringwood State Park (Ringwood Borough, Passaic County and Mahwah Township, Bergen County). The proposed conveyances are needed for purposes of constructing, installing and operating pipeline loops (parallel to Tennessee’s existing pipelines) that will provide approximately 636,000 dekatherms per day (Dth/day) of new incremental natural gas delivery capacity to serve Tennessee’s northeast market area. The project is known as the Northeast Upgrade Project (the “Project”).

Tennessee is seeking Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approval and State permits and approvals from New Jersey (and Pennsylvania) to construct the Project from north central Pennsylvania to Mahwah, New Jersey to deliver additional supplies of natural gas to the Northeast and New England regions. This will complement expansion of the 300 Line in New Jersey of 16 miles in Sussex and Passaic Counties that was authorized by FERC in May 2010, approved and permitted by the Department in November 2010, and currently under construction. The proposed 323 and 325 loops are 10 mile and 7.6 mile loops, respectively. of 30-inch diameter pipeline on either end of the 300 Line. In addition, Tennessee is proposing to make modifications to Compressor Station 325 in the Township of Wantage, Sussex County and the Mahwah meter station in Bergen County, New Jersey.

In Highpoint State Park (Loop 323), the Project will affect seven (7) parcels of State-owned lands; in Long Pond Ironworks State Park (Loop 325), the Project will affect two (2) parcels of State-owned

lands; and in Ringwood State Park (Loop 325), the Project will affect fifteen (15) parcels of State-owned lands. In total, the Project as submitted to FERC for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is estimated to impact 113.37 acres of public lands in New Jersey, which includes 30.20 acres of new permanent ROW and 83.17 acres of new temporary, or construction workspace. These figures also include an additional 10% added by the Department for any unforeseen construction contingencies. Further, the Project will impact land in the Borough of Ringwood acquired by the Passaic River Coalition with Green Acres nonprofit acquisition funds in which the Department holds a conservation easement interest as well as privately held land in the Township of Wantage in which the Department holds a wetlands conservation easement interest.

Notwithstanding the above noted impacts, the Department has continued to direct Tennessee to submit a plan that significantly reduces the impacts to and use of State-owned lands in New Jersey and Tennessee is currently identifying opportunities to reduce both permanent and temporary impacts caused by the Project. As part of the reduction plan, Tennessee is proposing to relinquish up to 10 feet of its existing ROW associated with and on the non-construction side of the existing 300 Line.

If an acceptable alternative plan is submitted by Tennessee, the above scope of impacts to and use of State-owned lands will be reduced.

The specific blocks and lots of the lands in which NJDEP holds a conservation easement (privately owned) to be crossed or affected by the Project are as follows:

Block 311, Lots 1.01 and 1.03 (Ringwood, Passaic County, NJ) (Passaic River Coalition)
Block 152, Lot 9 (Wantage, Sussex County, NJ) (privately owned).

The Department is requiring compensation for the conveyance of the above-described State lands as follows:

- 1) For the lease and occupancy of up to 30.21 acres of State-owned land for a term of 25 years and the lease and temporary occupancy of an additional up to 83.17 acres of State-owned land for 2 years during construction, monetary payment to the State shall be at a rate of \$0.15 per square foot per year, escalated by 2.5% for each year after the first year of the lease for a total rent of approximately \$7.84 million over the 25-year term of the lease based on the current level of impacts as submitted to FERC. As the total acres impacted are anticipated to be reduced per the Department requested modifications of the original FERC submittal, the final lease amount will likely change but will still be determined using the square foot rate described above.
- 2) For the permanent ecological and environmental impacts to the approximately 30.21 acres of State owned lands, additional compensation shall be in the form of replacement land provided to the State at a ratio of 4:1.
- 3) In addition, Tennessee will be required to comply with New Jersey rules requiring avoidance, minimization, and mitigation for any impacts to sensitive environmental areas, features, or threatened or endangered animals or rare plants. Additionally, Tennessee will be required to compensate for the value of any timber resources impacted as well as comply with provisions of the No Net Loss Reforestation Act.

To be clear and avoid any doubt, the compensation to the Department above is independent of any other compensation required pursuant to law or regulation by any other federal, local or regional authority such as the Highlands Commission.

State House Commission approval is required for this proposal. If approved, the Department will enter into a 25-year lease with Tennessee in early 2012 so that construction on the Project may commence in 2012 in order to meet an anticipated in-service date of November 2013.
