Allen Weston serves as the Legislative Director for the New Jersey Association of Counties (NJAC), representing all 21 county governing bodies in advocating for legislation, regulations, and policy directives that empower county governments to operate more effectively and efficiently.

With almost a decade serving in this role, Allen is county government's chief advocate on environmental, public health, labor, procurement, and social benefit reform issues.
