### **PURPOSE OF THE HEARING**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has identified NPS pollution as the nation's largest water quality problem, causing impairment of approximately 40% of surveyed rivers, lakes and estuaries in the Country.

The New Jersey Clean Water Council (NJCWC) plans to seek public testimony on practices and approaches to address non-point source (NPS) stormwater pollution in impaired waterways. The NJCWC would be very interested in hearing your recommendations for reducing non-point sources of pollution and improving impaired watersheds.
