DEP UPDATES

Program updates provided by Jennifer Feltis Cortese

- Water Bank Update:
 - O The Water Bank had an outstanding month in December with staff from Municipal Finance and Construction approving 61 requisitions and setting a new record total of \$101 million. The program also closed on almost \$153 million in new short term loan funding for 11 projects, bringing the total closing thus far for this Fiscal Year to \$431 Million. This amount puts us on pace to exceed the old record of \$711 million for the year. From July to December 2020, the program closed on 58 clean water projects for \$370 million and five drinking water projects for \$61 million (for the total above \$431 million).
 - The NJ Water Bank has issued more than \$7.4 billion in low-interest long term loans and has an additional \$1.48 billion in short-term construction loans outstanding.
 - New Jersey's ratepayers have saved an estimated \$2.7 billion in interest costs and through Principal Forgiveness loans.
 - It is estimated that loan spending has generated over 140,000 direct construction jobs throughout the State.
- The CSO program meet with the City of Elizabeth and with North Bergen MUA- Woodcliff/ Town of Guttenberg to discuss their LTCPs and go over any comments or questions.
- Other: John Gray let the Council know that he will be leaving his position at DEP and thanked them for their support. Several council members returned the sentiment and thanked John for his assistance with the Council and wished him well.
