

10 SIMPLE STEPS TO SAVE WATER THIS SPRING



Save water and money by scheduling an irrigation audit.

1



Add compost to the soil.

6



Buy/build and install a rain barrel.

2



Avoid over-fertilizing lawns.

7



Use drip irrigation/micro-sprays instead of sprinklers.

3



Use mulch to reduce evaporation and weeds.

8



Convert a % of your lawn back to nature and plant native plants.

4



Postpone grass seeding until drought warning lifts.

9



Group plants based on water needs.

5



Use a broom instead of a hose to clean up sidewalks.
