Dear E-waste Reporting Entity:

Re: Extension of Electronic Waste (E-waste) Semiannual Report Submission deadline to September 30, 2020

On March 9, 2020, Governor Philip D. Murphy issued Executive Order #103 (EO 103) declaring the COVID-19 pandemic to be both a Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency in New Jersey. COVID-19 restrictions and limitations have made it difficult or impossible for reporting entities to collect and compile E-waste recycling data and to submit complete and accurate Semiannual Reports by the statutory due date of August 1, 2020.

On May 2, 2020, Governor Philip D. Murphy issued Executive Order #136 (EO 136) declaring a 60-day extension of the statutory deadline for reporting entities to submit the 2020 January-June E-waste Semiannual report to the NJ Department of Environmental Protection (Department), as required by the Electronic Waste Management Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.94 et seq.). Reporting entities include manufacturers, group plan administrators working on behalf of manufacturers, authorized recyclers, local government units and collection site locations identified in manufacturers' collection plans.

Therefore, in accordance with Executive Order No. 136, the Department is announcing the extension of the August 1, 2020 due date under N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.105c for submitting the 2020 January - June E-waste Recycling Semiannual Reports, to September 30, 2020. Recycling Semiannual Reports are now due to the Department no later than September 30, 2020.
