#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On March 11, 2019, respondent, Bio-Clean of New Jersey (Bio-Clean) was issued a Notice of Civil Administrative Penalty Assessment (NOCAP) by the petitioner, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Department, Solid Waste Compliance and Enforcement (NJDEP, Department), for violations of the New Jersey Comprehensive Regulated Medical Waste Management Act (the RMW Act) and its supporting regulations. The Department issued Bio-Clean a Notice of Civil Administrative Penalty Assessment (NOCAPA) claiming violations of N.J.A.C. 7:26-3.2(c), 16.3(a); and 7:26H-1.6(a). Bio-Clean denies any violation of the law claiming that Bio-Clean cleaned the areas in question and bagged the waste in question which constitutes a "cleanup" and thus, the exemption for self-generated waste applied.

#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Bio-Clean appealed and requested an administrative hearing on April 7, 2019, and the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) as a contested case. N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15; N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13. A hearing was held via Zoom on February 3, 2022, and the record closed after post-hearing submissions were filed on May 4, 2022, and May 12, 2022. An initial decision was issued on June 6, 2022, reversing the decision of the NJDEP, finding that the NJDEP failed to prove the violations by a preponderance of the credible evidence, as the only evidence of the violations was in the form of uncorroborated hearsay statements from unnamed Borgata employees who did not testify at the hearing. Accordingly, no penalty was imposed by the undersigned in the initial proceeding. The matter was reversed by the NJDEP and remanded with direction to take additional testimony on the issue of the penalty. Testimony was taken via ZOOM on May 22, 2023, and the record closed at that time.

#### **TESTIMONY**

#### For petitioner

Robert Gomes is employed as a Bureau Chief for the NJDEP. He was responsible for the issuance of the NOCAP and the penalty in the within matter. He referenced the six violations and referenced the range of penalties that can be imposed from moderate to severe. There were six violations and the NJDEP felt that a mid-range penalty was appropriate given that there were several instances of the violations.

#### For respondent

Andrew P. Yurchek testified on his own behalf. He maintained that he felt that he did not violate the rules as he was always conducting a cleanup as well as transport which was not a violation of the law. He felt the NJDEP should be more lenient given the minor violations, if any, that occurred and his efforts to obtain the proper license once he was advised of the alleged violations. He referenced some proposed regulations for first time offences in New Jersey that have not gone into effect in support of request for leniency.

#### **LEGAL ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSIONS**

I CONCLUDE that the penalty of \$25,000 for the alleged infractions is reasonable and consistent with the New Jersey Civil Administrative Penalty Assessment in this matter.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the **COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**, who by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection does not adopt, modify or reject this decision
