Each Project Area will be eligible for a grant of up to \$100,000.00. Individual applicants may apply for up to four (4) Project Areas. DEP reserves the right to limit the number of Projects awarded per applicant.

Project Area #1

Complete this section for <u>one</u> Project Area. If applying for more than one Project Area, subsequent sections will be provided. Applicants applying for more than one Project Area should add them to this form in priority order (e.g. the highest priority Project Area should be completed in this Project Area #1 section, followed by the next priority in the Project Area #2 section, etc.).

Project Areas may be a neighborhood, census tract, municipality, county, tribal land, or other delineation and must be located in an overburdened community (OBC) in New Jersey.

DEP's Transportation Needs Index tool may be used to help determine project areas. The tool provides a baseline analysis of areas throughout the state where transportation gaps may disproportionately affect vulnerable populations. It also includes an overlay of New Jersey's OBCs to help applicants see which areas are eligible. Applicants may also use DEP's Environmental Justice, Mapping, Assessment, and Protection Tool (EJMAP) to determine eligible project areas.
