Site Remediation & Waste Management Program (SRWMP): Amy Bowman (NJDEP-SRP) provided an update.

Changes coming this year for the ground water quality standards. Proposal will be coming out in May 2022 for rulemaking and adoption in 2023. Some compounds will have changes exceeding an order of magnitude. (1,1 biphenyl, cobalt, free cyanide, 1,3 dichlorobenzene, heptachlor (epoxide,) methoxychlor, vinyl chloride)

EPA 1633 will NOT be added to the Part III. It is an option for labs to request as a user defined method through the ATP process, but the part III will not have separate codes for EPA Draft 1633. The existing user defined PFAS codes currently listed on the Part III should be used to request EPA Draft 1633 as a user defined method option.
