## **CHANGES TO PART III**

In response to new technologies, newly regulated parameters and to provide pathways for laboratory certification that meet the needs of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, the OQA has updated the laboratory certification methods/parameters/techniques (Part III) it offers for certification. ## **EPA Method 1633 Final Version Publication**

The EPA's Office of Water, in partnership with the Department of Defense's (DoD) Strategic Environmental Research and Development Program, has published the final EPA Method 1633, "Analysis of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in Aqueous, Solid, Biosolids, and Tissue Samples by LC-MS/MS," a method to test for 40 PFAS compounds in wastewater, surface water, groundwater, soil, biosolids, sediment, landfill leachate, and fish tissue. As this is now considered the final validated method, the OQA will only offer and grant certification for the final January 2024 published version of the method. If your laboratory currently holds certification for a draft version of the method, your renewal scope has been updated to remove reference to "draft" and it will be updated to reflect the January 2024 version of the method, and you will be required to comply with the final January 2024 version as of July 1, 2024.
