This preconstruction approval is issued under the authority of Chapter 106, P.L. 1967 (N.J.S.A. 26:2C-9.2).

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.33(e), this preconstruction approval authorizes the permittee to begin construction and installation of the change proposed, at the permittee's own risk, if applicable, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.33. **The permittee shall not operate the change proposed until final issuance of the significant modification. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.12(a), the public comment period for your draft significant modification has closed. This preconstruction approval requires the permittee to comply with the draft conditions of approval, which are effective on the date of this preconstruction approval, during the construction and installation of the proposed change. The EPA oversight procedure will now begin on the proposed operating permit modification. N.J.A.C. 7:27-22 requires a mandatory EPA oversight period of 45 days from its receipt of the proposed permit. The EPA has the authority to request the Department to revise the conditions in the proposed permit. The Department may change the conditions as a result of the EPA's request.

If, in your judgment, the Department is imposing any unreasonable condition of approval in this permit modification action, you may contest the Department's decision on the modification and request an adjudicatory hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14b-1 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.32(a). All requests for an adjudicatory hearing must be received, in writing, by the Department within 20 calendar days of the date you receive this letter. The request must contain the information requested in N.J.A.C. 7:27-1.32 and the information on the NJ04 - Administrative Hearing Request Checklist and Tracking Form available at <https://dep.nj.gov/wp-content/uploads/boss/applications-and-forms/administrative-hearing-request-checklist-and-tracking-form.pdf>.
