Jersey Avenue Closure

Q: Why is Jersey Avenue closed?

A: Jersey Avenue is closed to construct the foundation and rails for the flood barrier gate. This closure is necessary to provide the safety of both the workers and the public while construction is undertaken.

Q: How long will Jersey Avenue be closed?

A: The initial full closure is expected to last approximately 1 month. It is the intention of the project to provide one lane of southbound traffic after that initial month during the remaining 2 months of work being performed. We are working diligently to complete this phase of the work as quickly as possible and will provide updates on the expected reopening date.

Q: What are the detour routes during the closure?

A: Northbound traffic entering Hoboken on Jersey Avenue will be diverted onto 18th Street to enter Hoboken via Grove Street or Henderson/Marin Boulevard. Westbound traffic on Observer Highway will be detoured onto Grove Street and Henderson/Marin Boulevard. Please follow posted signs and directions from traffic officers. Additionally, no large truck traffic will be allowed in this area during the closure. Please see additional slides provided by Hoboken available on our website to review the detours.
