Regarding: prohibition on use of polystyrene foam products

To: Potential polystyrene foam food service product waiver applicants:

As you may know, beginning May 4, 2022, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.129 (the Law), no person or food service business in New Jersey shall sell or offer for sale any polystyrene foam food service product, and no food service business shall provide or sell any food in a polystyrene foam food service product. The Law named several exemptions from this polystyrene foam food service product prohibition.

Please note, the following product exemptions are valid until May 4, 2026, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.129(d):

- 1. Meat and fish trays for raw or butchered meat, including poultry, or fish that is sold from a refrigerator or similar retail appliance
- 2. Any food product pre-packaged by the manufacturer with a polystyrene foam food service product
- 3. Any other polystyrene foam food service product as determined necessary by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department or NJDEP)

For products that are not exempt, the Law provides an opportunity to request a waiver from the polystyrene foam food service product prohibition by application to, and approval from, the Department. The form with which to request a waiver to sell/provide a specific polystyrene product not exempted above, is attached to this letter and the applicant should provide as much detail and background information as possible to assist the Department in determining if a waiver is appropriate. A separate application must be submitted for each product for which a waiver is requested.

Any approved waivers will be for a period not to exceed one year unless otherwise extended in writing by the Department upon receipt of a written application for extension received no less than 30 days prior to the expiration of the waiver.
