Current Contractor Activities

Northern Region

- Side scan sonar surveys will continue in Raritan Bay and Raritan River
- Debris and target recovery will continue along the Hackensack, Cheesequake Creek and Raritan Bay.

Central Region

- Side scan sonar surveys will continue in Zone 6 west of Island Beach State Park and begin in Zone 3 (ocean side of Monmouth County).
- Recovery of visible, floating, and targeted debris will resume in Island Beach State Park, Good Luck Point, Cedar Creek and Lanoka Harbor, and south towards Forked River to the Barnegat Bay Inlet.

Southern Region

• Debris recovery in progress in the areas of Seven, Little Sheephead, and Hither Islands, the Atlantic City area, and Fortescue State marina, the western shores of LBI, Wetecunk Creek, Barrel Island, Seven Islands; and within Steelman's Bay, Pleasantville, and the Maurice River.
