1. Open an internet browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari)
2. Proceed to: <https://www.accsp.org/>
3. Click on the SAFIS box on the left, under the banner.
4. Enter your username and password.
5. Click on the “eTRIPS/REDESIGN” link.

HOME PAGE

This page is what a user is see when logging into SAFIS eTrips. On the left hand side there are options for entering reports and favorites. There are two types of reports that can be filed. A Did Not Fish Report (No Fishing Reports), and a Positive Harvest Report (Enter Report). A did not fish report can be submitted as a range of days for a given month or months. A positive harvest report is submitted everyday fishing activity occurs. Below are step by step instructions on how to submit both types of reports.



Once a negative report is complete the license holder can view the trips and the calendar on the right-hand side of the page will be blue with the trip ID. If license holder wants to download negative trip report, they can by using the action drop down button.

Positive Harvest Report (Enter Report)

FAVORITES

New Jersey Fish and Wildlife strongly suggests creating favorites prior to entering a positive harvest report. Favorites are useful especially if a harvester is fishing same gear day after day. A user can create favorites for one or more gear types and fish targeted within the system. For example, a harvester uses a gill net to target menhaden in the spring and a crab pot to target blue crabs in the summer. A user can simply turn on and off which gear they will be entering.

Tricks and Hints for Favorites

- A user can populate a data box by either clicking on the box and writing in field then hit the enter button or using the table to the left in the box which will produce a drop-down box.
- A user can add and delete as many things as they want in favorites. To delete go the favorite you want to delete, check the box next to it and click the red delete. The favorite will be crossed out. Finally click the green save button to complete the action.
- Make sure to use the green "Save Trip" button after completing each section.

Port State – New Jersey

Port – Port that the trip is coming into (A user can use the actual port name or port county) Example – Atlantic City or Atlantic County

Vessel State – Most of the time it will be New Jersey

Vessel – New Jersey Fish and Wildlife has entered vessel data in for many users, but we know that we do not have all user's vessel data. The two options for entry is to email SAFIS administration at njcommercialreporting@dep.nj.gov or call (609) 748-2020 to update vessel information or enter 9999 into data box and use the UNKNOWN -NJ9999.

Trip Attributes – After saving click on the link, it will ask you the number of crew (including the captain) on each trip. If this changes constantly leave it blank and you can enter your crew information when filling out the trip report. Please note that "Trip Attributes" may differ and be required depending on regulations.

Default Trip Header – This shows which trip header the user wants to see when entering a trip report. The user has the option to select one or more. Select "yes" to see when entering report and "no" to make it not show up on the trip report. Remember to save after changing!

Market – What type of product is going to market. For most species select “unclassified” or mixed. If catch is broken up by gender please select gender.

Disposition – What is happening to the catch. Food, Bait, Discards are popular options.

Grade – The grade of the species. For most species select “unclassified” or “round” but some certain species especially crab a user may select “hard” or “peeler”

Catch Source – Catch source for commercial trips is always standard.

Edit Species Attributes – For majority of species this is will be left blank. If species has a certain management requirement you may enter it when entering your trip. For example tautog requires a number of fish caught for the tautog commercial tagging program.

ENTER REPORT

- Though favorites make reporting easier and faster a user may choose to enter a report without using them. Some users use this method if they are only submitting a positive trip a few times a year
- Even if favorites is inputted you still may change responses within the trip report without having to exit and update favorites.


