



SUBJECT: Atlantic Cobia Commercial Fishery Closure from December 18, 2024 through December 31, 2024

Per Addendum I to Amendment 1 of the Interstate Fishery Management Plan (FMP) for Atlantic Migratory Group Cobia, a commercial trigger is used to determine when to close the commercial fishery in order to fully utilize but not exceed the commercial quota. The trigger level is calculated to provide states with 30 days' notice to close the fishery, and in-season landings reported by non-*de minimis* states are monitored throughout the season against the trigger level.

As of November 18, 2024, the total reported commercial landings of Atlantic cobia in 2024 from non-*de minimis* states (New York, PRFC, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina) meets the commercial trigger level.

As a result, the Atlantic cobia commercial fishery in all state waters in the management unit (north of the Georgia-Florida state border) will be closed starting at 12:01 a.m. on December 18, 2024 through 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2024.

The closure applies to all states in the management unit, including *de minimis* states.

The Commission has requested that NOAA Fisheries implement a similar closure in federal waters to ensure complementary management measures.
