Important Notice Regarding Wild Bird Bill A-649 Amending R.S. 23:4-50: After December 10, 1991, wild caught birds may not be possessed, bought, sold, or bartered, except those which were in captivity legally before this date. All other birds regulated by NJFW must be captive bred with appropriate documentation. Leg band or microchip numbers must be listed.

The Bird Breeder permit is only for those who wish to obtain wild-caught birds (after 12/10/1919) to increase genetic diversity for breeding purposes. Birds held under this permit may not be sold or transferred except with prior written approval from the Wildlife Permits Unit. Species may not be crossbred to produce hybrids. All birds possessed under this permit must be fixed with leg bands or microchipped [N.J.A.C. 7:25-4]. If you plan to breed birds for sale, you must obtain a Pet Shop and/or Animal Dealer permit.
