



NOTE: This is a renewal form for the Exotic and Nongame Individual Hobby Permit. If you do not currently have a permit to possess regulated exotic and nongame animals, do not use this form! You will need to complete and submit the “Initial Exotic and Nongame Individual Hobby Permit Application.” You must provide documentation for all new acquisitions, or your renewal will be denied.

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NEW ACQUISITIONS: List all NEW animals/birds acquired during the previous year. Include purchases, animals born, sex, and source. Include all documentation for new purchases. If you attend a reptile show, you will need to request a sales receipt from the vendor. Attach additional sheets if necessary.
