

NEW JERSEY'S STRIPED BASS BONUS PROGRAM READ IMMEDIATELY UPON RECEIPT

Anyone failing to submit log and/or report Bonus harvest to NJ DEP Fish & Wildlife (NJFW) may <u>NOT</u> be considered for the Striped Bass Bonus Program (SBBP) the following year.

SBBP INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS:

1) If you harvest a Bonus Fish, it is <u>MANDATORY</u> to report it within 24 hours.

Securely attach permit/tag to fish through mouth and gills immediately upon capture and prior to transportation.

To report a Bonus fish:

- Online Harvest report form: <u>dep.nj.gov/sbbp-harvest-report</u>
- **Call:** Leave a message at 609-748-2074. This line is *only* used to report harvest of a Bonus fish. ****Reporting Bonus Harvest on the Fishing Log at the end of the season will NOT satisfy this requirement****
- Mandatory reporting information includes name, permit #, phone number, date of harvest, and fish length.

2) Submit Fishing Log at end of season even if you did not fish.

Complete trip log and mail to NJ DEP Fish & Wildlife or submit online at <u>dep.nj.gov/sbbp-logbook</u> by January 15th, even if you did not fish, to remain eligible for the following year.

Instructions:

- Fill out the log for **yourself only** and list fishing days individually, not grouped together.
- Record all striped bass fishing trips even if no stripers were caught.
- Please measure all fish caught and list all lengths on log. NO SIZE RANGES!
- Make as many copies of the log as necessary.
- If you harvest a Bonus fish, record the permit number used under the corresponding column.

New Jersey's Striped Bass Regulations:

- ▲ 1 fish 28" to 31" in all New Jersey waters.
- Visit our website <u>dep.nj.gov/marine-regulations</u> to check current Federal and State possession, season, and gear regulations for striped bass fishing in your area.

Striped Bass Bonus Program:

- Participants are allowed **one** striped bass from 24" to less than 28" per Bonus permit.
- One Bonus permit will be issued initially per person. After NJFW receives a harvest report, participants may be issued additional permits up to the discretion of NJFW. The quickest way to receive your next permit is by reporting Bonus harvest online.
- If the cumulative harvest weight reaches the annual quota, the program will close for the remainder of the calendar year.
- Bonus permits are non-transferable and **only valid from May 15 through December 31** for the calendar year issued.
