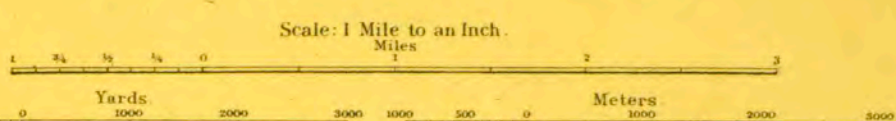


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP OF THE SOUTHERN INTERIOR

NOTE. The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which an open line passes are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from one line to the next is, as the figures will show, often greater than on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
