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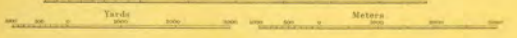


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP

NOTE: The contour lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are of the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The year or half year for the next 10, as the figures will show, 20 feet in the northeast and 10 feet in the southwest portion. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
