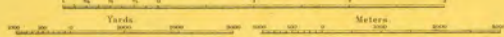


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP OF THE VALLEY OF THE PASSAIC

NOTE: The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The run of fall from any line to the next is shown by the figures in bold type and placed in the line. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
