Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:1D-5.1(a), the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is extending the comment period on the notice of proposal of amendments, repeals, and new rules to the Coastal Zone Management (CZM) rules, N.J.A.C. 7:7, Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (FWPA) rules, N.J.A.C. 7:7A, Flood Hazard Area Control Act (FHACA) rules, N.J.A.C. 7:13, and Stormwater Management (SWM) rules, N.J.A.C. 7:8, as well as several additional rules that cross-reference these four chapters, as part of a comprehensive update of the State's Land Resource Protection program to reflect the latest global, regional, and State-specific scientific information on climate change (see 56 N.J.R. 1282(a)).
