

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders is proposing to change the purpose or use of approximately 2 acres of Laurel Run Park located in Delran Township, Burlington County. Burlington County is proposing to execute an agreement with the New Jersey Agricultural Society and its Farmers Against Hunger program for use of the existing agricultural buildings and 1 acre of land for establishment of the Land Stewardship Center at Laurel Run.

Pursuant to **N.J.A.C. 7:36-25.6(a)1**, a hearing to obtain public comment on this proposed change of use will be held on December 9, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Delran Township Municipal Building located at 900 Chester Avenue, Delran Township.
