

PUBLIC SCOPING HEARING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that Hudson County has contacted the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Green Acres Program, proposing to permanently divert approximately 2.445 acres of a wetland area in Hudson County's Laurel Hill Park (Block 1, Lot 3 in the Town of Secaucus), for the construction and operation of the Portal North Bridge. The purpose of the overall Portal North Bridge Project, sponsored by NJ TRANSIT, is to replace the aging Portal Bridge and eliminate the associated capacity constraints on the Northeast Corridor.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.8(a) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.5 et seq., a scoping hearing to obtain public comment on this request will be held via Zoom Meeting on:

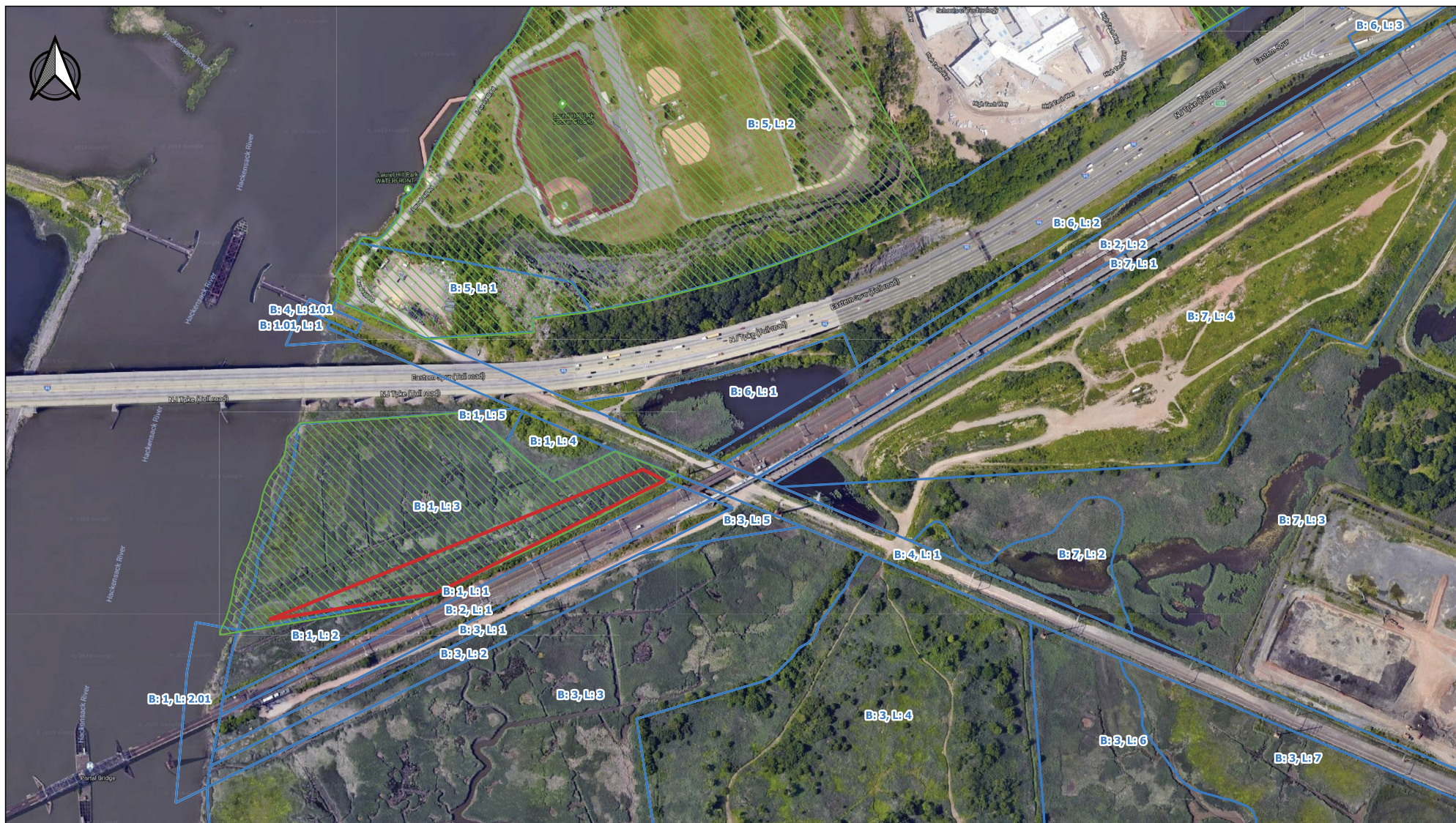
