GREEN ACRES PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that Hudson County will hold a public hearing to obtain comments regarding its application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Green Acres Program, proposing to permanently divert approximately 2.445 acres of a wetland area in Hudson County's Laurel Hill Park (Block 1, Lot 3 in the Town of Secaucus), for a Bridge Easement for the construction and operation of the Portal North Bridge. This hearing will also satisfy the requirement of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.5 et seq. "Sale, lease or exchange of real property of capital improvement by counties; conditions; fees." The purpose of the overall Portal North Bridge Project, sponsored by NJ TRANSIT, is to replace the existing and aging Portal Bridge with a new railroad bridge.

As compensation for this diversion of a Bridge Easement, a payment in the amount of \$54,800 (four times the \$13,700 appraised value of the diversion) will be deposited into the Garden State Preservation Trust Fund. In addition to the aforesaid contribution to the Garden State Preservation Trust Fund, NJ TRANSIT has also agreed to contribute the sum of \$179,000 to Hudson County for the rehabilitation of Laurel Hill Park to be utilized for waterfront enhancement and trail improvement, amongst other things.

Separate from, but in addition to the Green Acres process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.5 et seq. "Sale, lease or exchange of real property of capital improvement by counties; conditions; fees", the County has prepared a written report setting forth the reasons for, and all advantages and disadvantages of the proposed diversion, including the environmental and recreational impacts and the environmental and economic value of said diversion (as stipulated in N.J.S.A 40A: 40A:12-13.5(a)(1)). Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.5(a)(2), the report is available on: www.hudsoncountynj.org/. Pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:12-13.5(a)(3), this will serve as the second hearing, which is being conducted at least 14 days apart from the first held on November 4, 2020 and at least 90 days in advance of the date of the proposed sale, lease, or exchange.
