The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department"), State Park Service is accepting applications to store rowing shells/sculls, oars and related equipment for rowing at Long Pond Ironworks State Park. No motorized boats of any kind shall be stored on the Licensed Premises, except those used as safety launches in support of rowing activities. Applicants will be required to enter into a License Agreement with the Department for the rowing storage space. The Initial Term of the License shall expire on December 31, 2024. Licensee may request, in writing, and Department may, in its sole discretion, for cause or convenience, grant a Renewal of the License Agreement, which shall start January 1st and shall end December 31st ("Renewal Term"). Department may grant no more than two (2) subsequent Renewal Terms following the Initial Term of the License Agreement.

To apply, please complete the attached application and return it via email to PublicLandAdministration@dep.nj.gov. Storage Licenses will be awarded to applicants on a first-come, first-served basis. Four (4) Licenses will be issued. The Department reserves the right to issue additional Rowing Storage Licenses at the Area, at its sole discretion. Applicants must provide a ranked list of preferred storage locations, choosing from the options on the attached map; locations will be awarded on a first-come, first served basis. Additional details related to the terms and conditions of the license are provided in the attached License Agreement.

This opportunity shall be open until 4pm on May 1, 2024, or until all four (4) applications have been received and accepted by the Department, whichever occurs sooner.

Incomplete applications or applications that do not meet the requirements as provided herein will not be accepted. Department reserves the right to reject, in its sole discretion, any or all applications.
