TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:8B-5, known as the New Jersey Conservation Restriction and Historic Preservation Restriction Act, Hanover Township will be conducting a public hearing on the proposed release and replacement of a Patriots' Path public access and conservation easement held by the Township on a portion of the Hanover Towne Center property known as, 801-849 Route 10 East, Hanover Township (Block 4001, Lots 12, 13 and 14), owned by Hanover Towne Center, LLC. The Township will also conduct a public hearing pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:36-26.6(c), in conjunction with its application to NJDEP for the proposed disposal and replacement of this same aforementioned Patriots' Path public access and conservation easement held by Hanover Township. The proposed disposal is classified as a "minor" by the Green Acres Program.

As compensation, the Township and Hanover Towne Center, LLC have agreed to relocate and expand the Patriots' Path public access and conservation easement within the same redevelopment site. The current easement totals 0.84 acres. The new easement, totaling 1.04 acres, will include a pocket park and enable a safe pedestrian crossing at the signalized intersection at Route 10.
