This is in response to your application received by the Department on May 3, 2021, concerning a proposed compressor station within the above referenced Block and Lots in West Deptford Township, Gloucester County.

### **Decision:**

A review of the submitted material, including the following drawing/s, indicates that a stream encroachment permit **is not required** for this project:

“COMPRESSOR STATIONS, BLOCK 346.07, LOT 24 AND 25, WEST DEPTFORD, GLOUCESTER COUNTY, NEW JERSEY” sheet FHA-01, dated April 27, 2021.

### **Reason for Decision:**

Based on the review of the submitted information, the Department has determined that the proposed limit of disturbance is not located within a riparian zone or regulated area as per N.J.A.C. 7:13-2.2 and N.J.A.C. 7:13-2.3. A formal authorization for the proposed project is not required under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules.

### **Conditions:**

This determination is valid for five years and is conditioned upon the receipt of all other necessary approvals and permits. Any change in the scope or design of this project may result in the need for a stream encroachment permit. Also, any activity proposed within freshwater wetlands, transition areas or open waters will require a freshwater wetland approval from this office prior to construction.

All disturbed areas should be stabilized in accordance with the requirements of the local soil conservation district. Your municipal construction official should also be contacted to determine if this project complies with local flood ordinances and building codes. The municipality may modify the design of this project or deny its construction if such ordinances or codes are not met.
