We hope you had a happy and safe holiday season! As we ring in the new year, we are excited to announce that The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) will be holding a second stakeholder meeting to discuss P.L. 2021, c. 391, also known as New Jersey's Recycled Content Law.

During the first stakeholder meeting, we discussed rigid plastic containers, identification of a manufacturer and manufacturer registration. For the second stakeholder meeting the focus of the meeting will be: recycled content calculations and compliance certification reports. The stakeholder meeting will be held on January 26th from 1:00pm to 4:00 pm ET via Microsoft Teams.
