Notice of Administrative Change

Fee Schedule for Water Supply Allocation Permits

N.J.A.C. 7:19-3.6

Take notice that the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is adjusting fees for water supply allocation permits, temporary dewatering permits, and water use registrations set forth in the Water Supply Allocation rules at N.J.A.C. 7:19-3.6. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:19-3.4, the Department is adjusting the fees for inflation based on the previous 12-month United States Department of Labor Consumer Price Index (CPI), U.S. city average, all items, all urban consumers. As provided by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, on July 1, 2019, the applicable CPI is 1.8 percent. (http://www.bls.gov/news.release/cpi.t01.htm). Adjusted fees will be rounded for accounting simplicity, down to the nearest \$5.00 increment. The new fee schedule will be effective on January 1, 2020. The Department will send notice of the fee adjustment to current permit holders and registrants, and anticipates that the 2020 annual fee invoices will be issued in December 2019.
