originally promulgated. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), timely filing of this notice extended the expiration date of the chapter seven years from the date of filing.

The Division of Fish and Wildlife Rules govern the management and harvest of fish and wildlife within the State. The rules regulate the activities in Wildlife Management Areas by restricting certain activities such as swimming and camping while promoting wildlife related activities. The rules outline the procedure to obtain a permit to use devices for non-lethal control of depredating wildlife and outline the procedures for obtaining permits to take depredating wildlife in order to protect crops and property. The seasons, times, manner, and means (equipment, quantity, etc.) for the taking of game are regulated by the rules as well as the seasons, times, manner and means for harvesting freshwater fish, marine fish and shellfish for both recreational and commercial purposes. The rules also classify wildlife as game, food fish, nongame, threatened, endangered, or exotic, and regulate the collecting and possession of certain wildlife as pets, or for scientific, zoological or commercial purposes.
