Take notice that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the Water Pollution Control Act rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14 are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period. The rules had been scheduled to expire on October 5, 2017. The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed these rules and has determined that the rules should be readopted because they are necessary, reasonable and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), timely filing of this notice extended the expiration date of the chapter seven years from the date of filing.

The Water Pollution Control Act rules establish construction standards for wastewater treatment facilities and define the roles and responsibilities of the owner, the owner's representative or engineer, and the construction contractor. The rules address such items as mobilization costs, payments to contractors, and eligibility of certain items for projects that receive Federal construction grant assistance.

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The Water Pollution Control Act rules also set forth the procedures for assessment, payment, and settlement of civil administrative penalties for violations of the Water Pollution Control Act, N.J.S.A. 58:10A-1 et seq., the Act Concerning Pretreatment of Industrial Wastewater, N.J.S.A. 58:11-64 et seq., and the New Jersey Underground Storage of Hazardous Substances Act,

N.J.S.A. 58:10A-21 et seq.
