The rules had been scheduled to expire on November 4, 2020. gallons of water per day for agricultural, aquacultural, or horticultural purposes to obtain a water usage certification in order to divert that water. A certification allows a person to divert 100,000 gallons or more of water per day from ground and surface water sources for those purposes for a five-year period. A person who has the capability to divert 100,000 gallons or more but who does not divert and does not intend to divert that quantity of water must register the diversion source under the rules. The rules prescribe the application, review, notification, and modification and renewal procedures for water usage certifications and registrations.
