Notice of Deadline Extension for Submission of BDA Applications for BDA Designation Brownfield & Contaminated Site Remediation Act, NJSA 58:10B-1 et seq.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is extending the deadline for submission of Brownfield Development Area (BDA) applications for BDA designation. The original submission deadline was April 30, 2024. **The new deadline is July 31, 2024.**

The Department is accepting BDA applications for BDA designation for the purpose of promoting remediation and redevelopment in communities and neighborhoods affected by multiple brownfield sites.
