


## Remedial Timeframe Notification Forms

- Identify who is supposed to receive the request.
  - ► BCAIN via the <a href="mailto:srp\_submissions@dep.nj.gov">srp\_submissions@dep.nj.gov</a>
- Verify email submissions are acceptable/preferred with no paper copy of the form required.
  - Email Submissions are acceptable/preferred, and no paper copy is required unless requested by the Department.
- Identify any guidance/tips for PRCRs and LSRPs.
  - Submit request timely: 30 days prior to Regulatory timeframe and 60 days prior to Mandatory Timeframe.
  - Check compliance with previous submissions using the Data Miner Case Tracking tool before requesting an extension. Non-Compliance may result in a denial.
  - Verify dates are correct prior to submitting RTNF using the Data Miner Case Tracking tool. If data errors, email <a href="SRWM\_NJEMS@dep.nj.gov">SRWM\_NJEMS@dep.nj.gov</a>.
  - Submit one RTNF for each case (LSR Activity). Do not combine multiple requests on one form for different cases (LSR Activities)
  - Refer to the "Administrative Guidance Regarding Compliance with Remedial Action Report Timeframes (April 4, 2017)" document.


# Remedial Timeframe Notification Form Four Month Trend

### EO 103 and Timeframes

- ► February 1, 2021 Notice of Rule Waiver/Modification/Suspension
  - https://www.nj.gov/dep/covid19regulatorycompliance/docs/srpremedial-timeframes-20210201.pdf
- Need to have LSRP retained by:
  - March 18, 2021 (45 days after Notice was signed) for existing cases
  - Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26C-2.3 for new cases moving forward (and existing cases if current LSRP dismissed)

### EO 103 and Timeframes

- Extends timeframes for remediations not subject to statutory timeframes 455 days (including subsequent timeframes)
- Extends timeframes for remediations subject to statutory timeframes one year
  - May 2021 RTF or MTF extended to May 2022
  - May 2023 MTF extended to May 2024
- If an RTF was extended to an MTF, both timeframes are extended the same amount of time (i.e., the MTF is not reset to two years from the new RTF)

## **EO 103 and Timeframes**

- Statutory May 2014 soil-only cases
  - Regulatory timeframe for remedial action February 6, 2019 (N.J.A.C. 7:26E-5.8(b)1i)
  - Mandatory timeframe for remedial action February 6, 2021
  - Need to submit extension request by May 1, 2021
  - ▶ Will extend mandatory timeframe for one year to February 6, 2022
- Expedited site-specific timeframes <u>are not</u> covered by the Rule Waiver
