The Department has proposed amendments to the Administrative Requirements for the Remediation of Contaminated Sites (ARRCS) rules at N.J.A.C. 7:26C and the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation rules (Technical Regulations) at N.J.A.C. 7:26E that amends certain mandatory timeframes and regulatory timeframes. The proposal also amends the trigger for what constitutes a vapor intrusion immediate environmental concern in the Technical Regulations and creates a new class of cases that will be called "vapor concern" cases.
