There are also provisions for receiving an extension to the May 7, 2014 deadline if remediation is delayed due to obtaining state funding.

The Department will be posting information to its website beginning next week and continuing for the next few weeks, including a certification form, reports to determine whether a person responsible for conducting the remediation qualifies for the extension, and frequently asked questions. The Legislation requires that an electronic certification form be submitted by March 7, 2014. The Department is working to finalize this form and expects that it will be available for submittal via the Department's electronic portal no later than the second week of February. It is recommended that users check the website (https://www.nj.gov/dep/srp/ or https://www.nj.gov/dep/srp/timeframe/) daily to see what new information the Department has posted.
