## **Document Description:**

This technical guidance will define what a cap is, describe various types of caps, and discuss the factors and limitations to be considered in selecting a particular cap. The goal is to provide information that investigators can use to determine which caps are best for the remedial issues facing them. This Technical Guidance was developed with stakeholder input by the NJDEP Capping Technical Guidance Committee. The Department would like to thank Teruo Sugihara (DEP Committee Chair) and all the members of the Capping Committee for their time and effort in developing this guidance. Technical guidance may be used immediately upon issuance. To provide for the reasonable implementation of new technical guidance, the Department will allow a 6-month phase-in period between the date the technical guidance is issued final (or revised) and the time it should be used.
