On February 21, 2017, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) published a Notice in the New Jersey Register that the Remedial Action Workplan and the Remedial Action Report NJDEP Online Services are available for the submission of a Remedial Action Workplan (RAW) and Remedial Action Report (RAR). A copy of the notice is included below. This message is a follow-up reminder that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26C-1.6(c), the use of these services will become mandatory 90 days from publication of the letter, or on May 22, 2017, unless otherwise instructed by the Department. The ability to submit the RAW and RAR voluntarily through the NJDEP Online Service has been available since December 9, 2016.

Take notice that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) hereby gives notice that its online portal for the submission of the Remedial Action Workplan and Form and the Remedial Action Report and Form is now available, which allows persons to file electronically.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26C-1.6(c), within 90 days after the date that the Department informs the public, by a notice in the New Jersey Register, that an electronic portal is available, the person responsible for conducting the remediation shall submit to the Department via the electronic application such documents specified by the Department that are required by the Administrative Requirements for the Remediation of Contaminated Sites, N.J.A.C. 7:26C, and the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E.

Accordingly, beginning on May 22, 2017, the Remedial Action Workplan and Form and the Remedial Action Report and Form shall be filed electronically through NJDEP Online, <a href="https://www.ni.gov/dep/online/">https://www.ni.gov/dep/online/</a>.
