The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has adopted an emergency adoption of a temporary rule suspension of certain provisions of the Administrative Requirements for the Remediation of Contaminated Sites at N.J.A.C. 7:26C-4, Fees and Oversight Costs. Due to the ongoing state of emergency and the extension of Fiscal Year (FY) 2020, the Department is suspending the requirement to calculate Site Remediation Reform Act and Remedial Action Permitting fees for FY 2021. Instead, the Department will apply the current FY 2020 fees for FY 2021 as published in the June 17, 2019, New Jersey Register at 51 N.J.R. 1069(a). These fees shall remain in effect until FY 2022.
