The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's (NJDEP's) Site Remediation and Waste Management Program (SRWMP) will be providing detailed training on the updates to the Response Action Outcome (RAO) Guidance. The virtual training will be held on Tuesday, November 23, 2021, from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM via GotoWebinar (see registration information below).

The information provided in the RAO Guidance document provides Licensed Site Remediation Professionals (LSRPs) with the tools to prepare and issue RAOs. This training session will highlight the different types of RAOs, the structure and sections of an RAO, and how to modify, amend, and withdraw an RAO. The training will include a discussion on RAOs and Remedial Action Permits (RAP), how RAPs are incorporated into RAOs, and the future availability of the RAO online service.
